## *A Letter to the Installer*

Hello Foam it Green Installer,

Installing Foam it Green, even the first time, is easy. We're here every step of the way to help make this simple. If it's the first time you're doing this, prepare to be surprised in a good way!

The Foam it Green system is portable, disposable, and doesn't need any additional machinery or tanks to work. It's also been designed to be picked up and used by first time users easily and quickly. Within 30 minutes you'll be spraying like you do this everyday.

1. The goal is a tight air seal. Foam it Green expands to fill gaps and holes, so it's easy to get it done. If you miss a spot, you can simply go back. It's forgiving stuff.
2. The Foam it Green system has 2 tanks. The A tank and B tank have different chemicals. When the chemicals meet in the nozzle, they make foam that cures quickly.
3. When the chemicals mix properly, you will see the foam is light green and dries to the touch in a few minutes. That's one major way you know you're doing it right!
4. The chemicals spray on as a thin coat and then rise up to roughly 1 inch cured foam in one pass.

As you estimate out your work times, plan on taking 60 minutes to read the instructions, watch an online video or two, tape and prepare the work area, and set up the tanks. A 602 takes roughly 30-45 minutes to spray full out.

Please give us a call with any questions. Usually in 10 minutes we can answer all your questions PLUS send you an appropriate set of project instructions, etc. to help you.

After this there's a resource guide with shortcuts, a project planning worksheet, and a checklist to make sure the project is completed the way you want it.

### **5 Easy Shortcuts:**

1. Read the Instructions – the Foam it Green system sets up in minutes. It's important to read the instructions so you know what goes where.
2. Temperatures Matter – The chemicals and the surfaces need to be in the correct range in order to get great results.
3. Green Means Go – The Foam it Green system has blue and yellow chemicals that mix to make green foam. Green is a good indicator that the foam is mixing properly.
4. Stop and Measure – As you go, make sure things are going according to the Project Worksheet.
5. Ask Questions – As you prepare, feel free to ask us any questions. Likewise, take time during the project to call us if any new questions pop up. Our team is available to you 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, 365 days a year.

*Project Work List*

Here's a simple way to tie off on how far the kits should go and at what resulting thickness. It won't be exact but it should be pretty close.

**Step 1:** Measure the area to be covered:  
(Example: 8'high x30'long = 240sq. Ft.)

**Step 2:** Multiply that area by the thickness (in inches) that you want:  
(Example: 240 x 2") = 480 Board Feet.)

**Step 3:** Get the right amount of foam to cover (always include 10-20% extra so you make it easy).  
(Example: One 602 kit is 602 board feet, so should cover 480 Board Feet. - ie; 240 Square Feet at 2" thick)

## *Installer Checklist*

The Foam it Green system has some simple and easy ways to help you make sure the installation is done properly.

### **Here's how to know:**

1. Light green color shows the chemicals mixed properly.
2. The foam is dry and firm to the touch after 15 minutes and there are no blue, wet areas.
3. A cured thickness approximately as thick as described on the Project Worksheets.
4. Tight air seal – no big cracks and no pulling away from the wall past 24 hours after spraying. *(If cracks or pulling away occurs within 24 hours, just seal with a bead of foam to get the tight air seal.)*

If everything is done, then it's time to let the owner know and have them take a walk through.
